- Registration with the Ontario College of Social Workers or Social Service Workers is required;
- Hourly paid position including 7 hours a week clinical counselling and 3 hours Tuesday evenings every other week, (2.0 group facilitation, 1.0 preparation);
- Valid driver's license and access to a vehicle required;
- Experience working with LGBTQ youth and communities;
- Experience dealing with high risk youth, crisis intervention and managing conflict;

The OK2BME Program offers a set of support services for LGBTQ youth and their families. The OK2BME Group Program is a bi-weekly psycho-educational and social /recreations drop-in group for LGBTQ youth between the ages of 13–18.
